

'Images of Horfield & Beyond'

Photographic competition 2020 to raise funds for Horfield Methodist Church



Would you like to see your photo reproduced as a greetings card (blank inside to be used for a variety of purposes) or a Christmas card, sold to raise funds to be shared equally between Horfield Methodist Church and the North Bristol Foodbank?

If so, get snapping!

We are looking for winning photographs celebrating Horfield and its adjoining neighbourhoods.

Imagine that you are choosing a card to send as a notecard, greetings card or Christmas card, to a friend or relative – what sort of picture would appeal to you?

Possible subject matters might be a local landmark, a landscape or maybe wildlife in your garden. We're looking for photographs that show off the best of 'Horfield and Beyond'.

Competition rules:

- 1. Photographs must be taken within Horfield or any of its adjoining surrounding neighbourhoods such as Bishopston, Filton, Lockleaze etc (if in doubt about whether a particular location is permitted, please email: treasurer@horfieldmethodist.org.uk)
- 2. There will either be two 'main' winning photographs chosen, likely to be one for each of the following:
 - i) general blank greetings card
 - ii) Christmas card
- **OR** if it is deemed that several different photos would look more appealing as a collage on one or both cards, those photos would be deemed as 'shared' winners. See point 14 for prizes.
- 3. The closing date for entries is midday on Sunday 6th September 2020. Winners will be notified within 7 days of the closing date. Entries will be accepted from Sun 7th June.
- 4. Entrants may submit up to four photos in total as prints in colour, or black and white. An entry form must be filled in and submitted with your photo(s), together with the entry fee of £2.50 per photo.
- 5. As this is a fundraiser, if there are not enough entries received to cover the cost of printing the cards, the number of cards awarded as prizes will be reduced to ensure that Horfield Methodist does not lose money.
- 6. All photos submitted must be printed on photographic paper, a minimum of 7"x 5" and a maximum of 10" x 8".
- In addition, <u>all winners, once chosen, will need to provide the image digitally</u> as the cards will be printed from this for the optimum resolution/quality.
- n.b. If a digital image is not provided by the winning entrants, an alternative winner will be chosen.
- 7. Entrants must not be professional photographers. For the purposes of this competition, a professional photographer will be considered to be someone who has made money from selling any of their photos.

- 8. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Where an individual or a residential property, belonging to someone other than the photographer, are featured, the photographer must seek permission and be prepared to provide written consent, when requested by HMC (Horfield Methodist Church).
- 9. We are looking for original photographs, so entries must not have won a prize in any other competition.
- 10. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit, however by entering the competition <u>all</u> entrants grant to HMC the right to use them to create greetings cards which will be sold to raise funds for HMC and the North Bristol Foodbank. Also, HMC will have the right to exhibit any of the submitted photographs at the proposed Arts and Crafts Exhibition at Horfield Methodist Church on Saturday 19th September 2020.
- 11. Prizes may not be awarded to any of the competition organisers, judges or their families.
- 12. Entries will not be returned so please remember to keep a copy. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted and no feedback on any entry will be provided (although entrants are welcome to attend the exhibition on Saturday 19th September 2020 and may collect their photo(s) at the end of the exhibition that day).
- 13. All photographs will be judged on the following criteria: Suitability for use for greetings cards as detailed in point 2 Public appeal Composition Originality
- 14. (to be read in conjunction with point 2) Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - If your photo is chosen to be a single ('main') photo on the card, your prize will be 10 greetings cards printed with your photo
 - If your photo is chosen to be one of two or more ('shared') photos on the same card, you will receive 5 of the greetings cards which include your photo
- 15. A maximum of one 'main' prize per entrant. However, up to two (1 'main' + 1 'shared', or 2 'shared') prizes in total per entrant may be awarded.
- 16. HMC reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
- 17. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules.
