services were amazing over the two days, with all the young people and adults coming together to sing and express their joy and love of their faith.

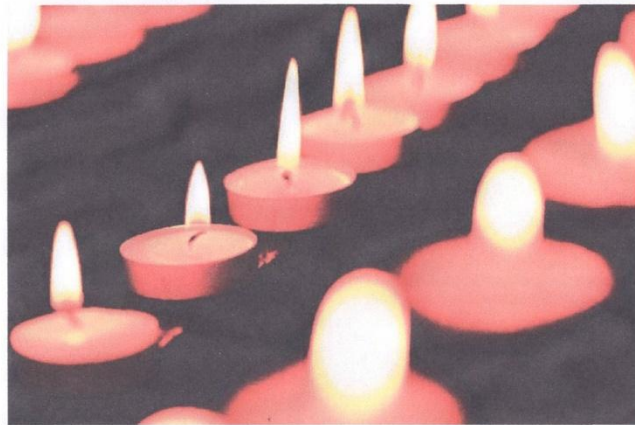
