Please read this message from A Rocha UK and consider taking part during Lent.

This Lent, take part in Climate Steward's Carbon Fast. Lent is a time when Christians traditionally fast and focus on God. The Carbon Fast will help you consider ways to live more simply, give you new ideas to cut your carbon footprint and invite you to focus on God and consider the whole of his creation. Beginning on 5 March, you'll receive a weekly email containing key facts, suggestions for how you could reduce your carbon footprint and a prayer to lead you through this Lenten season. **Winter Eco Tip.** If you have a water butt linked to a drain, empty the water butt into the drain when it isn't raining. This allows space for heavy rain to fill up the water butt rather than flowing into the drain. Reducing the amount of water going into drains during heavy rain can help to prevent flooding and overflowing into rivers.


